Maintained effort: Continue the efforts. The inspector observed committed and welcoming staff during today's visit. The educational staff focused on the children, were available with care, guidance, and started activities with space for all children. The staff were seen to be competent and dedicated.

2. Inclusion and community

Adjust effort: The inspector observed fine play opportunities for all the children. The staff were attentive and helped the children who needed it. There was a good variety of child-initiated games and then the activities that the staff were responsible for initiating and managing. The children's communities have good conditions in Rooftop and the staff are good at supporting them.

During the meal in the kitchen/dining room, the inspector did not see any children who were given the opportunity to scoop up food themselves or pour water into their cups. It would be a good idea to give the children the opportunity to do this in the future. Both to promote their sense of independence, to focus on (practice) self-reliance, and to give the children the opportunity to choose between specific food dishes.

There were good conditions for the small conversations that were held around the institution. The staff were good at meeting the children at each of their levels, expanding the conversations, playing around with the children through language and giving room for the children's response.

Overall assessment and follow-up:

During the unannounced visit to Rooftop, a nice positive interaction between the children and the adults was observed. Many different activities took place, with a well-considered educational aim and the staff seemed welcoming, appreciative and engaged in their work with the children.

The children seemed uninhibited in their contact with each other and the adults - the inspection saw children moving freely and safely around the institution.
